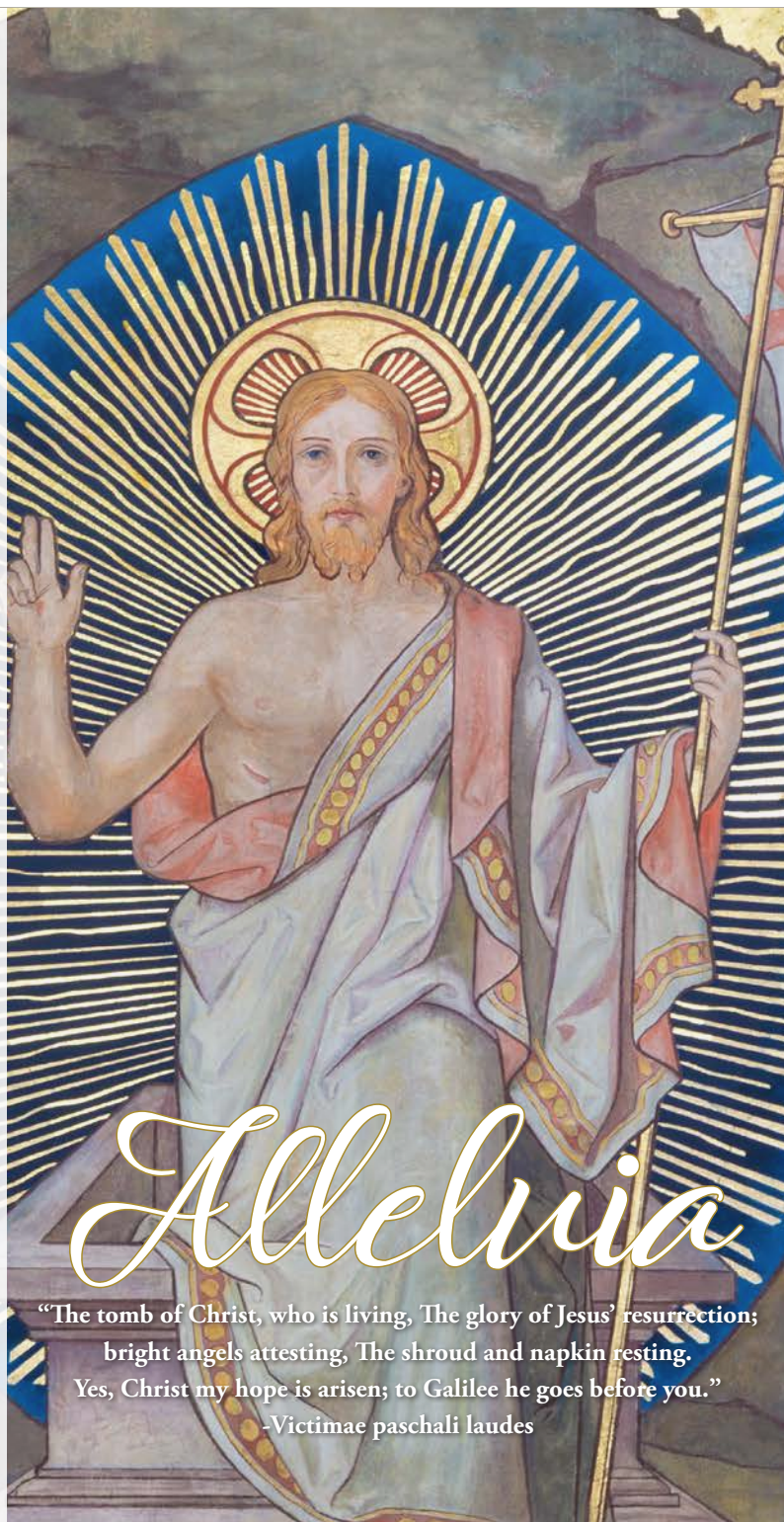

FROM THE PRIEST

This weekend is the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, marking forty days after Jesus' Resurrection, where Jesus appears to His disciples many times to make sure they know He had risen and to get them ready to continue His work that Jesus started during His time here on earth...Also, it is Jesus' departure and ascension...

Jesus' departure and ascension was a finish and a start for His disciples. Even though it was the end of Jesus' time on earth, it started the beginning of Jesus' presence with them in a new way!

Jesus promised that He would be with them always, till the end of time, and now that He's glorified and risen and ascended to the right hand of the Father in Heaven, He sends the Holy Spirit who would anoint the disciples with power, just as Jesus was anointed for His ministry at the Jordan River with John the Baptist!

When Jesus left His apostles, they were not sad, but excited that the Holy Spirit would come and anoint them!

Jesus' last words to His apostles was focused on their mission – a mission to be witnesses of His death and Resurrection and to share the good news of the Gospel of salvation! And even more, God's love and salvation is not for a "select few," but for the whole world for those who accept it!

This is the call that Jesus gives to the whole Church, and we also need to remember that we are not alone in this task – Jesus works in and through us by the Holy Spirit and He pours His Holy Spirit upon us to renew and strengthen the Body of Christ to all the nations!

Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, may the Lord fill us with a joy that nothing on earth can remove! May we be continued witnesses of the Gospel and understand His victory over sin and death!

You make the world a joyful, loving place! May Mary pray for all of you! Flowers will be given to all mothers after all Masses. Below is a prayer for all mothers:

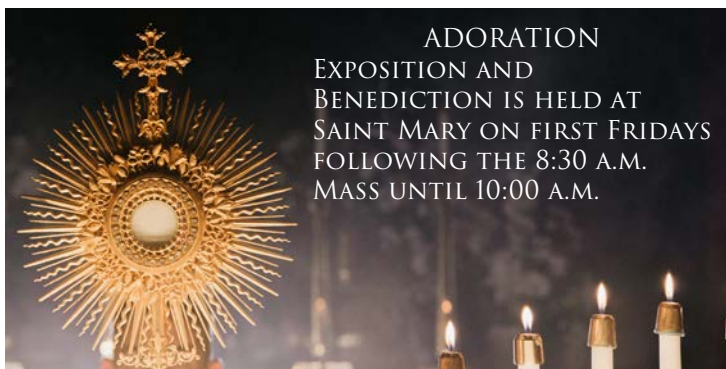
