## FROM THE PRIEST

John the Baptist is one of my favorite saints. Why may you ask? Because he had one desire in his life – to show others Jesus Christ and the coming of His kingdom!

John was filled with the Holy Spirit since he was in his mother's womb (Luke 1:41) and recognized Jesus even then! John was even led by the Spirit to go to the wilderness where he grew in the Word of God and was tested numerous times!

John began his ministry and began to speak the Word of God to the people of Israel like the Old Testament prophets where John wanted a real conversion of heart and real repentance!

The Old Testament prophets and the people of God were waiting for a long time for the Messiah to come, and John's mission was to reawaken them and show them that Jesus is the Messiah they were waiting for!

John baptized people for repentance – to turn away from sin and begin a new life according to God's Word. Our Baptism in Jesus Christ by water and the Holy Spirit gives us a new birth and we become members of God's kingdom as His sons and daughters! Jesus Christ comes to baptize each one of us in His Holy Spirit so we know His truth and know the joy of sharing the Gospel with everyone we encounter!

Like John the Baptist, our lives are called to show others Jesus Christ and we need to ask whether our lives are Christ-centered!

May our hearts be on fire with the Holy Spirit, and may we be faithful witnesses to the truth of the Gospel and show others the truth of Jesus Christ!

- **Because it's the Advent Season, we have opportunities for penance and to adore the Lord:**
  - Penance is always 45 minutes before every weekend Mass.
  - We have Adoration/Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday evening from 5:00-6:15 p.m. with penance available; Mass follows at 6:30 p.m.
  - There is a School Penance Service on December 15 from 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. with three confessors – parishioners are welcome to come.
- There is also the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe December 12. We will have a procession with the statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe starting at 5:00 p.m. around the block (with the recitation of the Rosary in Spanish) and Mass at 6:30 p.m. in Spanish; all are welcome to attend!

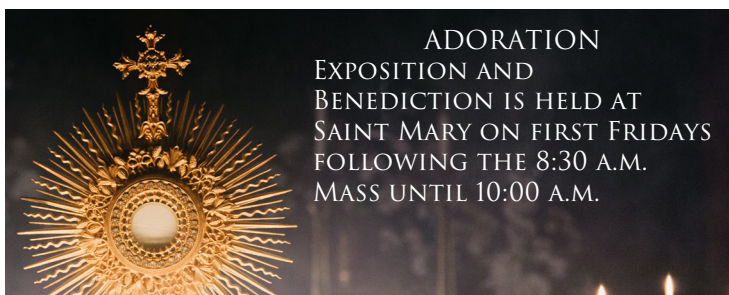

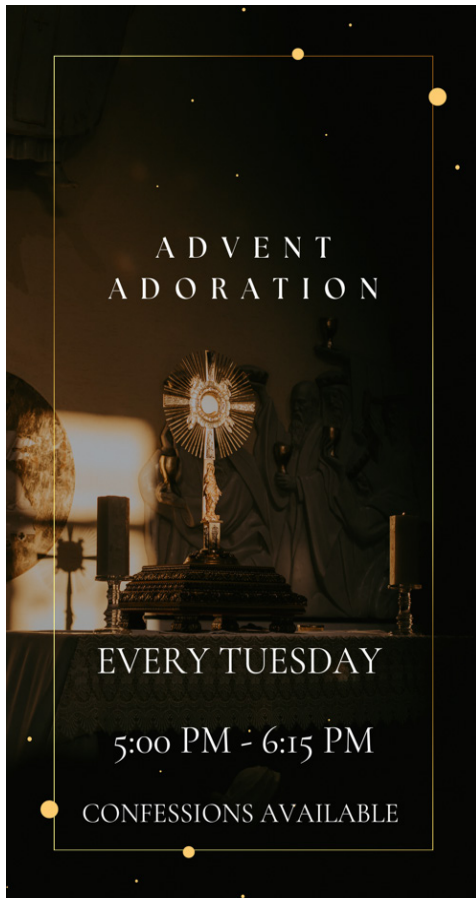

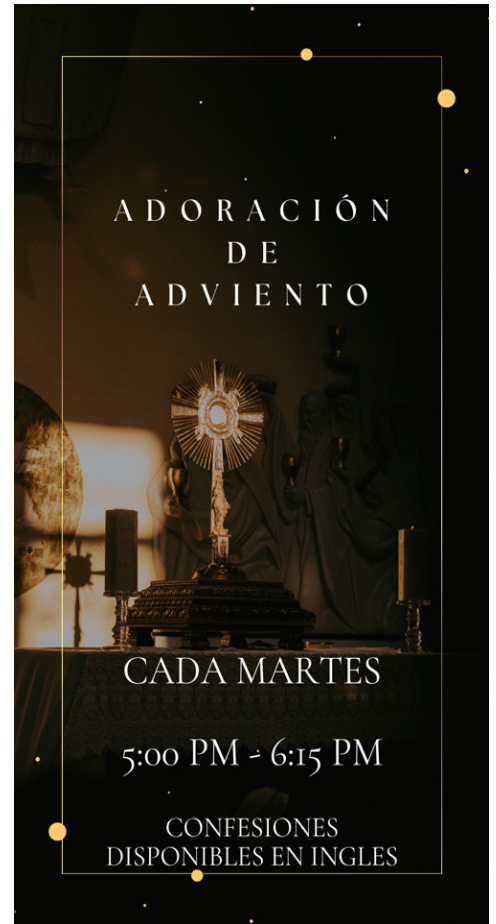
