## FROM THE PRIEST

On this Fourth Weekend of Lent, we are reminded of the healing power Jesus provides of what He endured on the cross!

Earlier in John's Gospel, Jesus spoke to Nicodemus and foreshadowed that His death on the cross would bring healing, forgiveness, new birth in the Holy Spirit and eternal life (John 3:3-15)!

Jesus tells Nicodemus that the "Son of Man" (a title from the prophet Daniel) must be "lifted up" to bring the authority of God's Kingdom on the earth! And when kings started to rule during the time of Jesus, they were literally "lifted up" and enthroned above the people! Jesus died on the cross because He is the "Anointed King" when He is "lifted up" on the cross at Calvary!

Jesus dies because He is God's only Son sent by God the Father to redeem and heal and reconcile His people with the Father in Heaven!

Jesus also discusses Moses and the people who were bit by "poisonous snakes" in the wilderness. Many people died because of rebelling against Moses and God, but through Moses' prayers and pleading, God showed mercy to the people, and instructed Moses to "make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole, and everyone who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live" (Numbers 21:8).

Jesus points to a key prophetic sign which Moses performed in the wilderness right after the people of Israel were afflicted with poisonous serpents. Scripture tells us that many people died in the wilderness because of their sin of rebellion towards Moses and God. Through Moses' intervention, God showed mercy to the people. This miraculous sign was meant to foreshadow and point to the saving work which Jesus would perform to bring healing and salvation to the world.

The serpent that was on the pole that Moses lifted up was a foreshadowing of Jesus on the cross! As the pole was lifted up, so Jesus, being "lifted up" on the cross, risen from the dead and His Ascension frees us from sins; is our "new birth" in the Holy Spirit (by making us temples of the Holy Spirit) and makes us adopted sons and daughters of God!

God truly loves us and wants us to be united with Him for all eternity by sending His only Son to suffer and die on the cross, which is the best He had to offer to us!

God's love is so redemptive that it covers the whole world, but it's also a personal love for every single human person whom God has created and cannot wait till all of us will come back home to Him!

May we always, always see the healing power of Jesus's death and may His love transform our lives so we may do His will above anything else!

## DEL SACERDOTE

*¡En este cuarto fin de semana de Cuaresma, recordamos el poder sanador que Jesús proporciona por lo que soportó en la cruz!*

*Anteriormente en el evangelio de Juan, Jesús habló con Nicodemo y prefiguró que su muerte en la cruz traería sanidad, perdón, nuevo nacimiento en el Espíritu Santo y vida eterna (Juan 3:3-15).*

*¡Jesús le dice a Nicodemo que el "Hijo del Hombre" (un título del profeta Daniel) debe ser "levantado" para traer la autoridad del reino de Dios a la tierra! Y cuando los reyes comenzaron a gobernar durante el tiempo de Jesús, ¡fueron literalmente "levantados" y entronizados sobre el pueblo! ¡Jesús murió en la cruz porque Él es el "Rey Ungido" cuando es "levantado" en la cruz en el Calvario!*

*¡Jesús muere porque es el único Hijo de Dios enviado por Dios Padre para redimir, sanar y reconciliar a su pueblo con el Padre Celestial!*

*Jesús también habla de Moisés y del pueblo que fue mordido por "serpientes venenosas" en el desierto. Mucha gente murió por rebelarse contra Moisés y Dios, pero a través de las oraciones y súplicas de Moisés, Dios mostró misericordia al pueblo y "haría una serpiente ardiente, y la pondría sobre un asta, y todo el que fuera mordido, cuando viere vivirá" (Números 21:8).*

*Jesús señala una señal profética clave que Moisés realizó en el desierto justo después de que el pueblo de Israel fuera afligido por serpientes venenosas. Las Escrituras nos dicen que muchas personas murieron en el desierto a causa de su pecado de rebelión hacia Moisés y Dios. A través de la intervención de Moisés, Dios mostró misericordia al pueblo. Esta señal milagrosa estaba destinada a presagiar y señalar la obra salvadora que Jesús realizaría para traer sanidad y salvación al mundo.*

*¡La serpiente que estaba en el poste que levantó Moisés era un presagio de Jesús en la cruz! Así como el poste fue levantado, así Jesús, siendo "levantado" en la cruz, resucitó de entre los muertos y su Ascensión nos libera de los pecados; es nuestro "nuevo nacimiento" en el Espíritu Santo (al hacernos templos del Espíritu Santo) y nos hace hijos e hijas adoptivos de Dios!*

*Dios realmente nos ama y quiere que estemos unidos a él por toda la eternidad enviando a su único Hijo a sufrir y morir en la cruz, ¡que es lo mejor que tenía para ofrecernos!*

*El amor de Dios es tan redentor que cubre el mundo entero, pero también es un amor personal por cada persona humana que Dios ha creado y no puede esperar hasta que todos regresemos a casa con Él.*

*¡Que siempre veamos el poder sanador de la muerte de Jesús y que Su amor transforme nuestras vidas para que podamos hacer Su voluntad por encima de cualquier otra cosa!*

- *¡Oremos por el Papa Francisco y todos los que dirigen la Iglesia, especialmente el obispo Fernandes!*
- *Oren por los afectados por desastres naturales y actos de violencia (Israel/Palestina; Ucrania; Burkina Faso; Haití; California Blizzard; accidente aéreo en Nashville)*

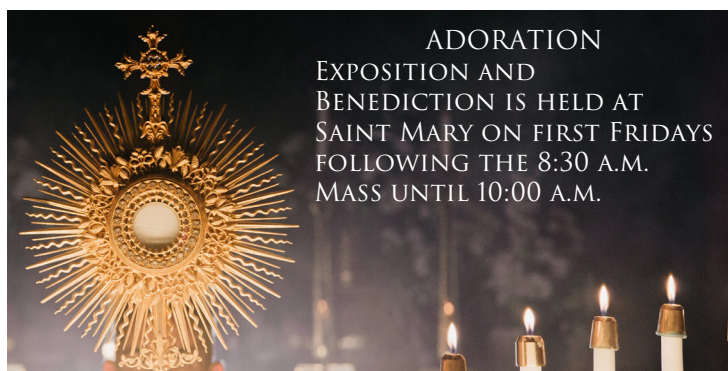

### WILL YOU HOST THE VOCATIONS CROSS FOR A MONTH?

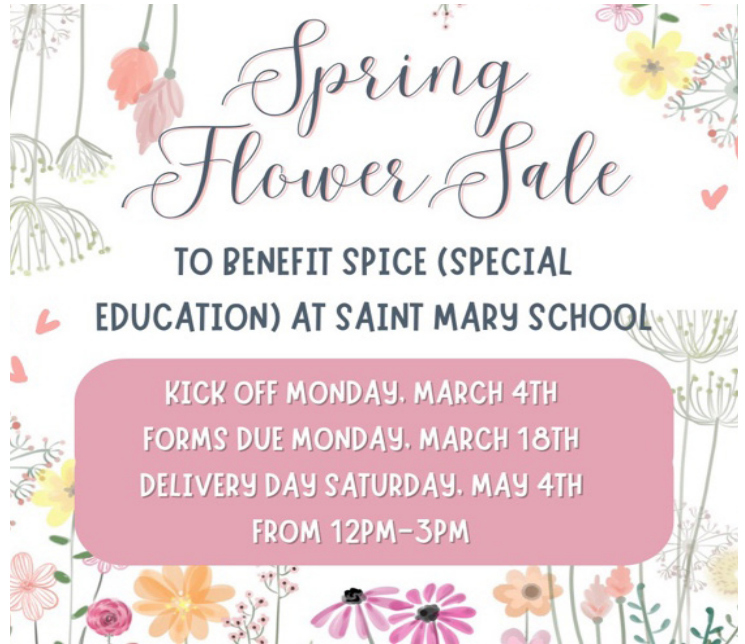
What is it?
