FROM THE PRIEST

Is there a place for Jesus, the King and Savior of the world in our hearts?! This weekend is Palm Sunday, and we hear in the Gospel Jesus arriving in Jerusalem, knowing what would be there (rejection, suffering, and crucifixion). The people of Jerusalem were ready to proclaim Him as their Messiah King, but did not know how much it would cost Jesus to be Messiah King...

St. Augustine, the great 5th century church father, comments on the significance of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem:

"The master of humility is Christ who humbled Himself and became obedient even to death, even the death of the cross. Thus He does not lose His divinity when He teaches us humility... What great thing was it to the king of the ages to become the king of humanity? For Christ was not the king of Israel so that He might exact a tax or equip an army with weaponry and visibly vanquish an enemy. He was the king of Israel in that He rules minds, in that He gives counsel for eternity, in that He leads into the kingdom of heaven for those who believe, hope, and love. It is a condescension, not an advancement for one who is the Son of God, equal to the Father, the Word through whom all things were made, to become king of Israel. It is an indication of pity, not an increase in power." (Tractates on John 51.3-4)

Jesus came to bring us the Kingdom of God and offer us peace and everlasting life for those who accept Him as the Messiah King!

If He is our Messiah King, then we need to ask ourselves whether or not we've let Christ into our hearts so we may think about Him before anything else in our lives!

May Jesus be the King of our hearts and our lives and may we have the humility to honor Him before ourselves!

Easter Prayer of St. Hippolytus of Rome

Christ is Risen: The world below lies desolate
 Christ is Risen: The spirits of evil are fallen
 Christ is Risen: The angels of God are rejoicing
 Christ is Risen: The tombs of the dead are empty
 Christ is Risen indeed from the dead,
 the first of the sleepers,
 Glory and power are His forever and ever.

DEL SACERDOTE

¿Hay un lugar para Jesús, el Rey y Salvador del mundo en nuestros corazones? Este fin de semana es Domingo de Ramos y escuchamos en el evangelio a Jesús llegando a Jerusalén, sabiendo lo que habría allí (rechazo, sufrimiento y crucifixión). El pueblo de Jerusalén estaba listo para proclamarse como su Rey Mesías, pero no sabían cuánto le costaría a Jesús ser Rey Mesías ...

San Agustín, el gran padre de la iglesia del siglo V, comenta sobre el significado de la entrada de Jesús a Jerusalén:

"El maestro de la humildad es Cristo que se humilló a sí mismo y se hizo obediente hasta la muerte, y muerte de cruz. Por eso no pierde su divinidad cuando nos enseña la humildad... ¡Qué gran cosa fue para el rey de los siglos! ¿Para convertirse en el rey de la humanidad? Porque Cristo no fue el rey de Israel para exigir un impuesto o equipar un ejército con armas y vencer visiblemente a un enemigo. Él fue el rey de Israel en el sentido de que gobierna las mentes, en el que da consejo para la eternidad, en cuanto que conduce al reino de los cielos a los que creen, esperan y aman: es una condescendencia, no una promoción, para quien es el Hijo de Dios, igual al Padre, el Verbo por quien todos "Se hicieron todas las cosas para ser rey de Israel. Es una indicación de compasión, no un aumento de poder". (Tratado sobre Juan 51.3-4)

¡Jesús vino a traernos el Reino de Dios y ofrecernos paz y vida eterna para aquellos que lo aceptan como el Rey Mesías !

Si Él es nuestro Rey Mesías, entonces debemos preguntarnos si hemos dejado que Cristo entre en nuestros corazones para poder pensar en Él antes que cualquier otra cosa en nuestras vidas.

¡Que Jesús sea el Rey de nuestros corazones y de nuestras vidas y que tengamos la humildad de honrarte ante nosotros mismos!

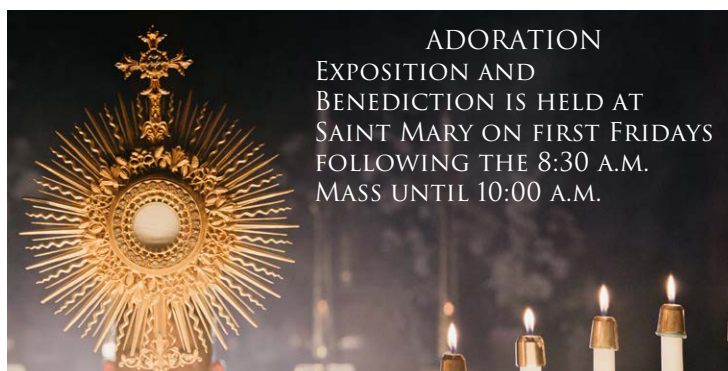
