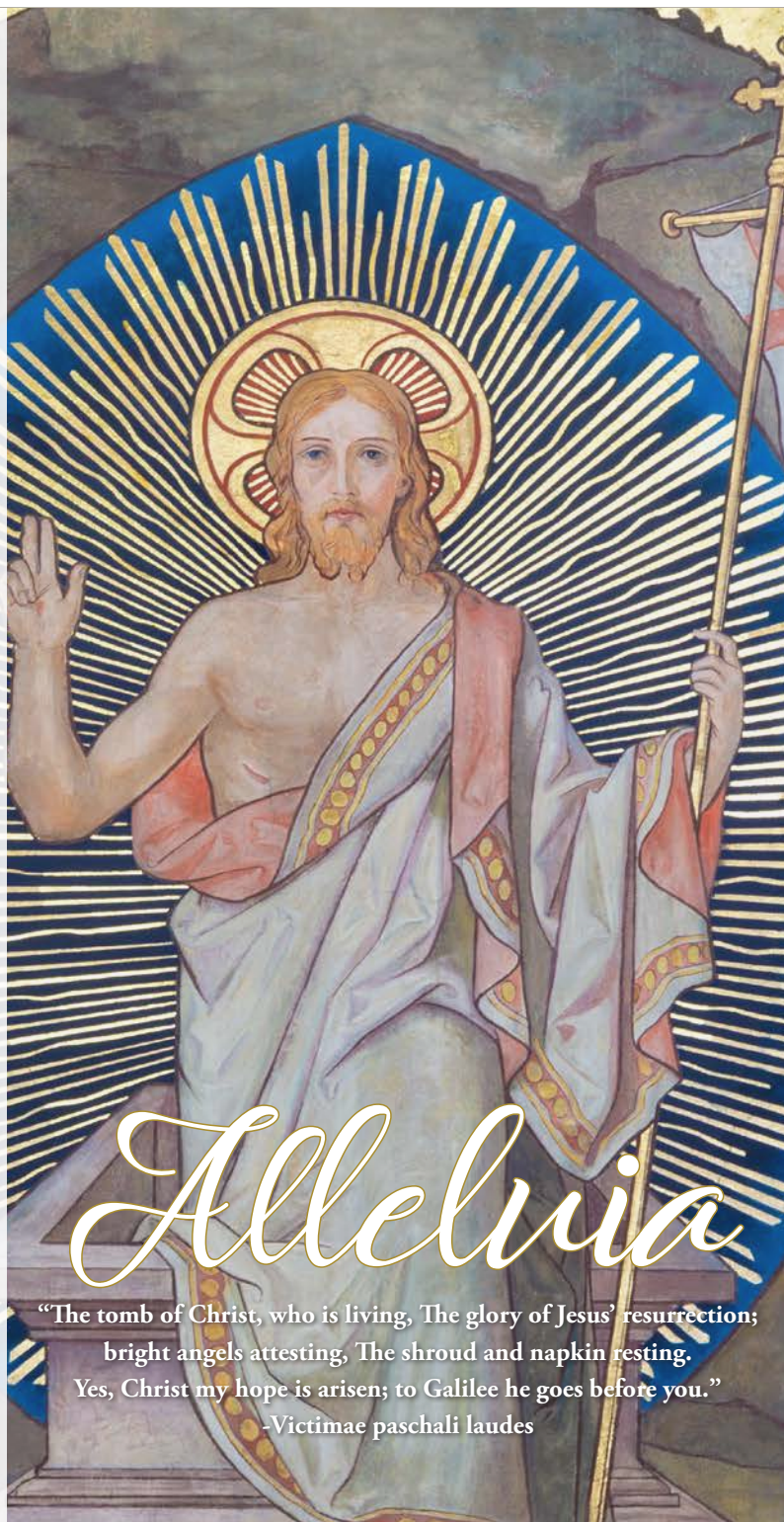

I wonder if we know the most awesome, central fact of our faith – the power of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ?

I wonder how I would react if I saw Jesus' empty tomb? How would it be for John, the faithful disciple, who had stood at the cross of Jesus and then put Him in a tomb on Good Friday, to come back to the tomb after three days, and realize the tomb was empty?

John, Peter, Mary Magdalene and the other disciples were not ready to see an empty tomb, or even hear the angel's message, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" (Luke 24:5)

I think John realized when he saw the empty tomb, through the eyes of faith, everything Jesus said was true, even about His resurrection after three days. John was a true friend and witness to Jesus Christ – in His life, death and Resurrection. And, if it wasn't for Jesus rising from the dead and appearing to His disciples, we would have never known about Jesus because nothing else could change those disciples, and the people of the world would be left in sadness.

Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit and with the "eyes of faith", may we see Christ's death and Resurrection as Good News and trust in Him at all times!

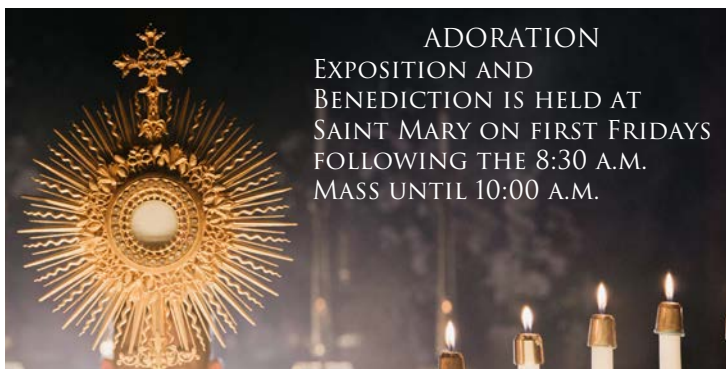

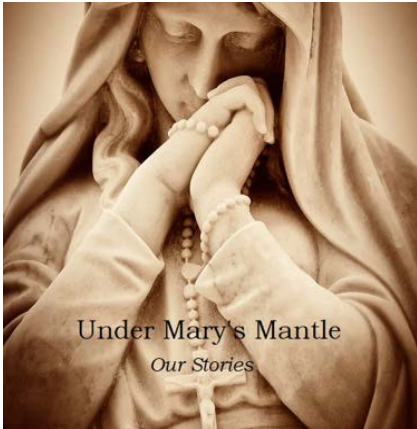
